Create transparency within the agency Create values in performing duties And it should be practiced as an honest culture of the Lat Nam Khem Subdistrict Administrative Organization. Therefore, the policy has been announced to all executives, employees, officials, and personnel under the supervision. Do not accept gifts and gifts of any kind from the performance of duties (NO GIFT POLICY). All festival occasions and special occasions both during/before and after performing duties That will result in corruption and misconduct. According to the regulations of the Office of the Prime Minister regarding giving or receiving gifts by government officials, B.E. 2001, together with the announcement of the National Anti-Corruption Commission on the criteria for receiving property or other benefits.
